Ajay Bisaria is a strategic advisor and commentator on international affairs. He has had a distinguished diplomatic career spanning 35 years as a member of the Indian Foreign Service (1987 batch), when he dealt with some of India's key economic and security relationships. He served as Indian High Commissioner to Canada (2020-2022) and Pakistan (2017-2020). He earlier served as India's ambassador to Poland and Lithuania (2015-2017). He has also represented the country at the World Bank in Washington DC and in embassies in Berlin and Moscow. He has served in various capacities in the Ministry of External Affairs, Department of Commerce and the Prime Minister's Office, where he was a key aide to Prime Minister Vajpayee from 1999 to 2004. He has dealt extensively with India's Eurasia policy, including with Russia, Ukraine and Central Asia. He has published and lectured on issues related to trade, finance and geopolitics, with a focus on South Asia, Eurasia, Central Asia and Canada. He has a Bachelor's Degree in Economics from St Stephen's College, Delhi University, an MBA (Finance and Marketing) from IIM Calcutta and a Master's Degree in Public Policy from Princeton University.
